

Ashuelot River Campground
Coronavirus Update - July 20, 2020

When you come, this is what you need to expect:

All of the following are in effect “until further notice”.

- **New England residents** are welcome without restriction - NH, ME, VT, MA, CT, RI.
- Out of New England residents must be willing and able to attest to the following as a condition of making a reservation: that the person(s) in [your] party have remained at home for at least 14 days before arriving in NH, only going out for essential items and when outside of the home maintaining social distancing and wearing face masks when within less than 6 feet of others.
- We prefer you to be in a self-contained RV, travel trailer or motor home, with a working toilet and sink in your rig.
- The bathhouses, including showers, are open, with limited capacity. The facilities will be cleaned and disinfected every four hours during the day, but not through the night.
- Cabins and tenting available on a very limited basis.
- If you plan to camp with friends or family, you’ll need to use your best judgment in the context of protecting one another from virus exposure: limit your movements to sites with friends and family only.
- Self-check-in is in place – stop and sign in on arrival; all reservations will be paid in full before arrival.
- The store is open; masks requested. The playground and game room are available, but will not be disinfected.
- Limited boat and bike rentals are available, shuttles are not available.
- Do not show up if you are symptomatic, or have been symptomatic within 10 days before arrival.
- Do not show up if you have been caring for, or living with someone who has been sick.
- If you appear unwell, we reserve the right to ask you to return home.
- Each camper is responsible for adhering to social distancing while at the campground – at least six feet of separation.
